The current climate within the Construction Industry makes it clearer than ever before that the effective and efficient exchange of information lies at the heart of collaborative relationships and leaner, smarter delivery of projects for our customers.

Building Information Modelling (BIM) is a collaborative way of working, underpinned by the digital technologies, which unlock more efficient methods of designing, constructing and maintaining our building and infrastructure assets.

One key competitive advantage of BIM is its ability to promote greater transparency and collaboration between our designers and our suppliers and thereby reduce waste (procurement, process and material).

The VINCI Construction UK Ltd Board and I are committed to the development and implementation of a Building Information Modelling (BIM) capability that has already become an integral part of the way we and our Supply Chain deliver projects.

Through our Digital Engineering Department this commitment is aimed at achieving:

- An increased awareness and understanding of BIM standards, specifications and protocols across the organisation.
- The development of a first-in-class BIM capability with the commensurate skills, experience and capacity
- Improved outcomes for all project stakeholders.
- Partnering with the UK BIM Alliance and BSI – a cross industry alliance to further the implementation of BIM Level 2 across the Construction Industry, its Supply Chain and its Customers.

These aims will be underpinned by all our VINCI Construction UK Management Plans, supported by a dedicated Digital Engineering team. Our company BIM level 2 approach will consistently drive the full life-cycle of our projects as we shift towards BIM Level 3 and digital transformation of the construction industry, towards 2025.

This policy will be reviewed annually and be adapted if changes to the company occur.
